1.1 Stable release

To install Fuga, run this command in your terminal:

```
$ pip install fuga
```

This is the preferred method to install Fuga, as it will always install the most recent stable release.

If you don't have `pip` installed, this [Python installation guide](#) can guide you through the process.

1.2 From sources

The sources for Fuga can be downloaded from the [Github repo](#).

You can either clone the public repository:

```
$ git clone git://github.com/ayemos/fuga
```

Or download the [tarball](#):

```
$ curl -OL https://github.com/ayemos/fuga/tarball/master
```

Once you have a copy of the source, you can install it with:

```
$ python setup.py install
```
